## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL CLR MEMBERS AND NON MEMBERS**

### **RE: CLR AUDIOMETRIC TESTING PROGRAM**

We have experienced situations in which participating contractors have scheduled a large number of workers to have audio testing done on site with the Program Service Provider (SureHire) and significantly fewer workers than scheduled were made available for testing.

As a consequence, our contract with SureHire now contains a penalty provision approved by the CLR Board of Directors to address the issue of significant numbers of “no shows”.

This provision applies when fewer than 80% of workers scheduled are made available to testing. When this occurs the Audio Testing Fund will be invoiced by SureHire for the number of tests not performed to reach the 80% threshold. (Ex – 100 scheduled – 60 tested – invoiced for 80 tests) **The Fund would invoice the participating contractor for the 20 tests not performed.**

SureHire will confirm the numbers scheduled with the contractor within 2 days of the day when the testing is scheduled commence.
