## **FUNDING MODEL**

This Funding Model for the Rapid Site Access Program is effective for the following trades under the registration certificates held by Construction Labour Relations—An Alberta Association (CLRa) in respect to all industrial hours worked and some maintenance hours worked:

Carpenters Cement Masons

Insulators Ironworkers Reinforcing Ironworkers Structural Labourers - Construction

MechanicalMillwrightsOperating EngineersPlasterers

Sheet Metal Sheeters, Deckers and Cladders

The funding rates are set by the CLRa Board of Directors and as at **January 1, 2016** are as follows:

**Industrial Construction:** 12.0¢/per hour worked

Commercial Construction: N/A

**Short Term and Shutdown Maintenance:** 

(e.g. National Maintenance Agreement) 12.0¢/per hour worked

**Long Term Maintenance:** 

(e.g. General President's Agreement) **6.0¢**/per hour worked

Fabrication Shops (who voluntarily choose to participate) 6.0¢/per hour worked

**Note:** The National Maintenance Agreement and the General President's Agreement make reference to the RSAP remittances applicable to maintenance.

**Note:** Fabrication facilities are bound to this funding model only if they voluntarily participate in the program. The funding for the fabrication shops will only be applicable once voluntary application to participate has been received and approved by the Board of Directors. Under these circumstances, the timing of implementation and funding commencement will be set in consultation with the voluntary applicant organization.
