



AUDIO PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Whereas Construction Labour Relations – An Alberta Association (CLRA) has established an Audiometric Testing Program (AUDIO); and

Whereas contribution to the AUDIO is compulsory for Contractors in those CLRA Trade Divisions which have authorized it pursuant to certain collective agreements negotiated by CLRA (mainly General Construction Industrial Sector) and the General Presidents’ Maintenance Committee of Canada; and

Whereas participation in the AUDIO is voluntary for Contractors who:

- employ workers pursuant to a collective agreement with one or more of the building trade unions in Alberta (e.g. UA Fabrication Shops or National Maintenance Agreement), or
- employ out of scope field or noise exposed workers in Alberta in jobs which would not otherwise be work covered by building trade affiliated unions; and

Whereas the following Contractor is signatory to one or more of the CLR-A collective agreements in Alberta; and

Whereas the workers in respect to which those contributions are made eligible for services provided through AUDIO;

Therefore, the following Contractor hereby applies to participate in the AUDIO subject to the terms and conditions contained herein.

Contractor’s Full Registered Name

In consideration of the provision of the AUDIO benefit, the Contractor agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Contractor shall remit to CLRA the current fee per hour worked for all bargaining unit workers and/or all out of scope workers specified in the application. This amount is subject to change upon 60 days written notice from CLRA.
2. The Contractor may revoke their participation in the AUDIO for voluntary groups of workers upon 60 days written notice to CLR-A for any reason. CLRA may cancel the participation of the Contractor for voluntary groups of workers for any reason upon providing 60 days’ written notice.
3. Applications for participation must include all CLRA trades employed in the category or sector for which the application is made.
4. The operation of the AUDIO and the determination of eligibility for benefits will be set by the Plan Rules which may be modified from time to time by CLRA upon 60 days’ notice. Plan Rules are available at <https://clra.org/initiatives/audio/>.
